Make your vote count

[Bulletin 11/2013](#) contains information about the ballot process. The ballot opens on Tuesday 3 December and closes Friday 20 December 2013, and I encourage you to have your say by casting a formal vote.

If a majority of employees who vote, vote YES, the first 3% increase will be paid effective from 21 November 2013.

If the ballot does not result in a YES vote then negotiations will resume and in accordance with the Wages Policy pay rises will occur from the date we reach agreement.

Ballots will be posted based on the address details contained in myHR as at 14 November 2013.
