TEACHER NEGOTIATIONS SET TO RESUME

On 1 September 2014 representatives of my office and the Department of Education met with Jarvis Ryan (A/President) and Peter Hardcastle (A/Secretary) of the Australian Education Union – Northern Territory branch (AEU-NT).

The meeting was the first time the parties have come together since the new union officials have taken up their posts. Its purpose was to hold preliminary discussions about returning to the enterprise negotiation table to discuss your employment terms and conditions. The parties agreed that negotiations were between the Commissioner for Public Employment (the employer) and the AEU-NT.

The meeting was very positive, with the AEU-NT committing to report back on their position in relation to negotiations after this weekend's AEU-NT Executive meeting.

I am heartened by this positive development and am keen to move matters forward. I will report further as negotiations progress.
