Make your vote count

[Dental Officers Bulletin 10/2014](#) contains information about the ballot process. The ballot opens on Monday 29 September 2014 and I encourage you to have your say by casting a vote.

If a majority of Dental Officers who vote, vote YES, and the Fair Work Commission approves the agreement, the first 3% increase will be paid effective from 28 August 2014.

If the ballot does not result in a YES vote the 3% increase will not be paid, and negotiations will need to start again.
