



DARWIN PORT CORPORATION - BULLETIN 10/2014

In-Principle Agreement – Subject to Consultation with Union Members

Bargaining has progressed well and yesterday in-principle agreement was reached with the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU), the Australian Maritime Officers' Union (AMOU) and the Maritime Union of Australia (MUA), on the final bargaining matters.

The unions are also considering a final draft of the proposed new 'Darwin Port Corporation (Northern Territory Public Sector) 2014-2018 Enterprise Agreement'. Unions reported they will consult with their members on the outcome of yesterday's meeting and the draft new agreement, and will advise me by Friday 27 June 2014 if they support the new agreement going to a ballot.

Next Step

I will inform you of the unions' position on the proposed new agreement, and confirm the ballot process for staff to vote on the agreement.
