Ballot Open

The ballot for the proposed 'Darwin Port Corporation (Northern Territory Public Sector) 2014 - 2018 Enterprise Agreement' has now opened. It is important that you have your say by voting on the proposed agreement.

Your vote needs to be received prior to the ballot closing at 1.00pm on 18 July 2014.

How to Vote

A secure ballot box from the Northern Territory Electoral Commission will be located in the human resources area of the DPC Administration Building. Employees may place their completed ballot paper in the ballot box during office hours.

Site visits to East Arm Wharf and city wharves will also be arranged for lodging ballots, and DPC will advise you when this will occur.

Make your vote count

Only if a majority of those who vote, vote YES, can the proposed agreement be approved and pay rises apply from 1 July 2014. I encourage you to take part in this ballot by casting your vote.
