Make your Vote Count

Only if a majority of those who vote, vote YES, can the proposed agreement be approved and pay rises apply from 1 July 2014. It is important for you to take part in this ballot to have your say and make your vote count.

How to Vote

A secure ballot box from the Northern Territory Electoral Commission is located in the human resources area of the DPC Administration Building. You may place your completed ballot paper in the ballot box during office hours.
