Union Claims Received

At a meeting held yesterday the Maritime Union of Australia (MUA), and the Australian Manufacturing Workers Union (AMWU), tabled their log of claims for a new Darwin Port Corporation Enterprise Agreement. As reported in previous bulletins the Australian Maritime Officers Union (AMOU) had already tabled matters for bargaining on 18 March 2014.

Next Step

Now that claims have been made by the three unions involved in bargaining I am able to finalise an offer for a new agreement, taking into consideration the matters raised by the unions, and in accordance with the [NTPS Wages Policy 2013-2016](#).

The next meeting has been scheduled for 30 April 2014 and a series of regular meetings have been set thereafter.
