Negotiations for a New Agreement

As you may be aware the current Marine Pilots' 2011-2014 Enterprise Agreement expired on 30 June 2014, and the Australian Maritime Officers' Union (AMOU) are currently considering my [revised offer](#) for a new agreement.

Proposed new classification structure

A new classification structure and progression model that will allow a more dynamic approach for operating in a multi berth Port has been provided to the union. The union requested clarification on a number of related matters, which is provided in the attached [Information Sheet 2/2014](#), along with:

- the proposed classification structure and definitions;
- progression descriptions; and
- a graph comparing Marine Pilot salary increases and Darwin CPI.

Next step

Discussions with the AMOU will continue over the coming days.

A meeting with all Marine Pilots, the DPC CEO, and representatives from my Office will be scheduled in the coming week to explain the proposed classification structure and the bargaining position.
