

DARWIN PORT CORPORATION - MARINE PILOTS BULLETIN 6/2014

In-Principle Agreement – Subject to Final Drafting

The Australian Maritime Officers' Union (AMOU) have provided in-principle agreement to my [offer](#) for a new enterprise agreement, subject to final drafting of the new agreement, and a letter of understanding to address the following matters that are separate to the agreement:

- Qualification Requirements for Marine Pilots;
- LNG Shipping to Bladin Point;
- Contract of Employment Provisions for Fixed Period Employees;
- Darwin Port Corporation Vehicle Use Policy; and the
- Northern Territory Government Death and Invalidity Scheme.

Draft copies of the proposed Darwin Port Corporation Marine Pilots' 2014 – 2018 Enterprise Agreement, and a proposed letter of understanding, have been provided to the AMOU for their confirmation of the agreed bargaining outcomes.

Next step

Once confirmed the proposed agreement will be provided to you for consideration before going to a ballot process. I will keep you informed of developments through further bulletins.
