Make your vote count

[Bulletin 5/2014](#) contains information about the ballot process. The ballot opens on Monday 10 February 2014 and closes Thursday 20 February 2014, and I encourage you to have your say by casting a vote.

If a majority of employees who vote, vote YES, the first 3% increase will be paid effective from 2 January 2014.

If the ballot does not result in a YES vote then I will need to consider available options, and in accordance with the NTPS Wages Policy pay rises will occur from the date we reach agreement.

How to Vote

Details of how to vote electronically, including an instruction sheet and your Personal Identification Number (PIN), will be sent via email to your NTG email address on Monday 10 February 2014. Employees on leave over the ballot period will also receive instructions posted to their nominated address contained in myHR.
