BARGAINING UPDATE

Current Negotiations

My last bulletin outlined the revised offer that I'd put to United Voice. That offer had significant concessions which would have seen fire fighters retain all of the current terms and conditions while also receiving four 3% salary increases over three years.

There continues to be a pursuit of claims that are outside the wages policy which I cannot agree to. I ask Fire Fighters and United Voice to re-consider their rejection of my offer which was:

- Four 3% pay increases over three years
- Roll over of the current agreement with all terms and conditions
- Agreement to expire on 7 November 2017.

As negotiations appear to again be at an impasse I'd invite United Voice to contact me should they wish to return to the negotiating table.
