On leave over the Ballot period?

If you are not at your nominated address from now until the close of the ballot period (4 October 2013) you will not receive the ballot material in the mail. However, you can still put in a vote if you:

- Contact the NT Electoral Commission (NTEC) and nominate a different address to have the ballot sent to; or
- Pick up a ballot form at an NTEC office in Darwin or Alice Springs; and
- Post your completed ballot paper during the ballot period (13 September – 4 October). Please note ballot papers received outside of this date period *will not* be accepted.

Change of address?

Don't forget if your address details have changed since 23 August you will need to contact the NTEC and ask to have your details updated in order to receive the ballot paperwork.
