Make your vote count

[Bulletin 30/2013](#) contains information about the ballot process. The ballot opens on Tuesday 22 October and closes Friday 8 November 2013, and I encourage you to have your say by casting a formal vote.

If a majority of employees who vote, vote YES, the first 3% increase will be paid effective from 10 October 2013.

If the ballot does not result in a YES vote then negotiations will resume and in accordance with the Wages Policy pay rises will occur from the date we reach agreement.
