Ballot papers will be posted by the Northern Territory Electoral Commission (NTEC) to your nominated address today for voting on the proposed NTPS 2013-2017 Enterprise Agreement.

The ballot material will include a ballot paper, ballot envelope and return post-paid envelope, which will ensure your confidentiality is maintained throughout the ballot process. Don't forget to sign your declaration for your vote to be valid and counted.

The Northern Territory Electoral Commission is an independent authority who manages the ballot process and counting of the votes.

The NTEC ballot process ensures that all employee personal details remain confidential, and that voting preferences cannot be identified.
