Ballot outcome

I am pleased to advise the Northern Territory Public Sector 2013 – 2017 Enterprise Agreement has been approved by a majority of employees who voted in the ballot process.

The result of the ballot conducted by the NT Electoral Office was as follows:

Implementation of the new Agreement

Now that it has been approved by a majority of employees who voted, it is necessary to lodge the Agreement with the Fair Work Commission for formal approval before it can commence.

The positive ballot outcome in support of the Agreement will provide the initial 3 per cent salary increase from 10 October 2013, and long term certainty and security of the new terms and conditions.

Payment of the new salary rates and adjustments to overtime or other relevant penalties will be processed following approval from the Fair Work Commission. A bulletin will be issued in due course with details of payment dates and commencement of new conditions.
