

PRISON OFFICER ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT BULLETIN 10

BALLOT NOW OPEN

The ballot for the proposed *Correctional Officer (NTPS) 2014-2018 Enterprise Agreement* has now opened. It is important that you have your say by voting on the proposed agreement.

Your vote needs to be received prior to the **ballot closing at 10.00am on Friday, 17 October 2014.**

How to Vote

A ballot paper with voting instructions has been posted to your registered mailing address. If you haven't received your ballot paper by 10 October 2014 you should contact Peter Burgess at the NT Electoral Commission (NTEC) by email to peter.burgess@nt.gov.au or by calling 8999 7622.

Completed ballots should be returned by mail, or lodged in person at an NTEC office in either Darwin or Alice Springs, and must be received prior to the ballot closing deadline.

Make your vote count

If a majority of the Correctional Officers who vote, vote YES, and the agreement is approved by the Fair Work Commission, then pay rises will apply from the first full pay period on or from 9 August 2014.

I encourage you to take part in this ballot by casting your vote.
